AN ACT

1 Amending the act of November 30, 2004 (P.L.1578, No.201),
2 entitled "An act amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the
3 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further defining 'common
4 carrier by motor vehicle'; providing for consumer protection
5 and information and for the protection of responsible
6 customer of public utilities; abrogating regulations; and
7 preempting local regulation," eliminating the expiration of
8 responsible utility consumer protection.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 5 of the act of November 30, 2004
12 (P.L.1578, No.201), entitled "An act amending Title 66 (Public
13 Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further
14 defining 'common carrier by motor vehicle'; providing for
15 consumer protection and information and for the protection of
16 responsible customer of public utilities; abrogating
17 regulations; and preempting local regulation," is repealed:

18 [Section 5. The addition of 66 Pa.C.S. Ch. 14 shall expire
19 on December 31, 2014, unless sooner reenacted by the General
20 Assembly.]

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
