## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judicial boards and
- commissions, authorizing the Pennsylvania Board of Law
- 4 Examiners to obtain criminal history record checks.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Chapter 21 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read:

- 14 <u>(a) Authorization.--The Pennsylvania Board of Law Examiners</u>
- 15 may require that persons applying for admission to the bar and
- 16 the practice of law in this Commonwealth submit:
- 17 (1) A Federal criminal history record check through the
- 18 Federal Bureau of Investigation.

- 1 (2) A State criminal history record check through the
- 2 Pennsylvania State Police.
- 3 (b) Fingerprints required.--If an applicant as required
- 4 under subsection (a) submits fingerprints to the Pennsylvania
- 5 State Police for the purpose of obtaining criminal history
- 6 record checks, the Pennsylvania State Police, or its authorized
- 7 agent, shall submit the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of
- 8 Investigation for the purpose of verifying the identity of the
- 9 applicant and obtaining a current record of any criminal arrests
- 10 and convictions.
- 11 (c) Use of information. -- Any information relating to an
- 12 applicant and obtained under this section by the Pennsylvania
- 13 Board of Law Examiners may be interpreted and used by the
- 14 Pennsylvania Board of Law Examiners to determine the applicant's
- 15 character, fitness and suitability for admission to the bar and
- 16 the practice of law in this Commonwealth.
- 17 (d) Inapplicability. -- The provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)
- 18 (2) (relating to general regulations) shall not apply if a
- 19 request for a criminal history record check is submitted
- 20 pursuant to this section.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
