AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), entitled "An
- act relating to the rights, obligations and liabilities of
- landlord and tenant and of parties dealing with them and
- amending, revising, changing and consolidating the law
- relating thereto, " providing for eviction for unlawful
- discharge of a firearm in an occupied structure.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of April 6, 1951 (P.L.69, No.20), known
- 10 as The Landlord and Tenant Act of 1951, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 506-A. Eviction for Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm</u>
- 13 in an Occupied Structure. -- (a) Conviction of a tenant for
- 14 unlawful discharge of a firearm in an occupied structure in
- 15 violation of 18 Pa.C.S. § 2707.1 (relating to discharge of a
- 16 firearm into an occupied structure) in any portion of a single-
- 17 family dwelling, apartment, multiple dwelling premises or
- 18 tenement building shall be a breach of the condition of the
- 19 lease and shall be grounds for the removal of a tenant from the

- 1 single-family dwelling, apartment, multiple dwelling premises or
- 2 tenement building.
- 3 (b) Failure to remove any tenant for violation of any of the
- 4 provisions of subsection (a) shall not act as a waiver of the
- 5 <u>landlord's rights with regard to the same or any other tenant</u>
- 6 relating to any subsequent acts.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
