

AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in post-trial matters,
3 further providing for report by district attorney.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 9561(b) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 9561. Report by district attorney.

9 * * *

10 (b) Definitions.--The following words and phrases when used
11 in this section shall have the meanings given to them in this
12 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

13 "Health care professional." A person licensed, certified or
14 registered by any of the State boards as defined in this
15 section.

16 "State board." Includes the following departmental
17 administrative boards within the Department of State: the State
18 Board of Medicine, the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the

1 State Board of Dentistry, the State Board of Podiatry, the State
2 Board of Pharmacy, the State Board of Nursing, the State Board
3 of Physical Therapy, the State Board of Occupational Therapy
4 Education and Licensure, the State Board of [Optometrical
5 Examiners, the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home
6 Administrators, the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, the
7 State Board of Psychologist Examiners and the State Board of
8 Examiners in Speech-Language and Hearing.] Optometry, the State
9 Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators, the State
10 Board of Chiropractic, the State Board of Psychology, the State
11 Board of Massage Therapy, State Board of Social Workers,
12 Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors, the
13 State Board of Examiners in Speech-Language and Hearing and any
14 other health-related administrative board which issues
15 professional or occupational licenses within the Department of
16 State.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
