

## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the service and sacrifice of our nation's Korean  
2 Veterans of the Vietnam War.

3 WHEREAS, The United States entered the Vietnam War to prevent  
4 a Communist takeover of South Vietnam and more than three  
5 million American troops fought bravely in the cause of freedom  
6 and democracy; and

7 WHEREAS, 58,193 American soldiers were killed and more than  
8 300,000 were wounded during the conflict; and

9 WHEREAS, Korean soldiers were sent to the Vietnam War to  
10 support American troops and the cause for freedom at the request  
11 of the United States; and

12 WHEREAS, 325,517 Korean soldiers served valiantly in Vietnam  
13 from 1964 through 1973; and

14 WHEREAS, 5,099 Korean soldiers were killed and 10,962 Korean  
15 soldiers were injured during the war; and

16 WHEREAS, The Korean soldiers who fought heroically alongside  
17 American soldiers were known throughout the conflict for their

2       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
3 significant and enduring accomplishments of our nation's Korean  
4 Veterans and confirm its commitment to preserving the memory of  
5 those who made the ultimate sacrifice during the Vietnam War.
