

AN ACT

- 1 Designating a bridge carrying State Route 1008 known as Pompey
- 2 Hill Road, over the Stonycreek River in Quemahoning and Stony
- creek Townships, Somerset County, as the Private John W.
- 4 Mostoller Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Private John W. Mostoller Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Declaration of policy. -- The General Assembly finds and
- 9 declares as follows:
- 10 (1) Private John W. Mostoller was a native of the
- village of Mostoller, Somerset County, and following
- graduation from high school, enlisted in the Union Army.
- 13 (2) Private Mostoller served in the Union Army from 1861
- 14 to 1864, by reason of muster out of company while holding the
- 15 grade of private, in Company B, Fifty-fourth Regiment of
- 16 Pennsylvania Infantry Volunteers.
- 17 (3) Private Mostoller received a medal of honor on
- 18 November 27, 1894, for most distinguished gallantry at the

- battle of Lynchburg, Virginia.
- 2 (4) When the officers of his company were absent or
- disabled, Private Mostoller voluntarily led a charge upon a
- 4 Confederate battery.
- 5 (5) His name was entered and recorded on the Army and
- 6 Navy Medal of Honor Roll on June 10, 1916.
- 7 (6) Private Mostoller was a guest of the War Department
- 8 at the entombment of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington
- 9 National Cemetery, when he participated along with a number
- of other veterans of the Civil War from other states.
- 11 (7) The Congressional Medal of Honor awarded to Private
- 12 Mostoller during the Civil War was presented to Somerset
- 13 County and is displayed inside the Union Street entrance to
- 14 the Somerset County Courthouse. It is the only Congressional
- 15 Medal of Honor won by a Somerset County soldier in the Civil
- 16 War.
- 17 (8) Private Mostoller, beloved son of Joseph and Sarah
- 18 (Mowry) Mostoller courageously served his country and has
- 19 been extolled by many for his bravery and service.
- 20 (b) Designation. -- State Route 1008, known as Pompey Hill
- 21 Road over the Stonycreek River in Quemahoning and Stonycreek
- 22 Townships, Somerset County, is hereby designated as the Private
- 23 John W. Mostoller Memorial Bridge.
- 24 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 25 maintain appropriate signs to indicate the designation under
- 26 subsection (b).
- 27 Section 2. Effective date.
- 28 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
