A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 30th anniversary of the creation of Ben Franklin
- Technology Partners and designating June 3, 2013, as "Ben
- Franklin Technology Partners Day" in Pennsylvania.
- WHEREAS, Ben Franklin Technology Partners (BFTP) was created
- 5 by the General Assembly and Governor Dick Thornburgh December 6,
- 6 1982, and is celebrating its 30th anniversary year in 2013; and
- WHEREAS, BFTP serves all 67 counties in Pennsylvania through
- 8 its four regionally based centers in Pittsburgh, University
- 9 Park, the Lehigh Valley and Philadelphia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, BFTP supports early-stage technology companies and
- 11 helps established manufacturers innovate by providing
- 12 investments, expert mentoring, incubation and accelerator
- 13 facilities and optimized access to university, investor and
- 14 industry networks; and
- 15 WHEREAS, This assistance combines to effectively leverage the
- 16 Commonwealth's funding commitment, helping BFTP companies
- 17 attract more than \$3 billion in follow-on financing in the last
- 18 five years alone; and

- 1 WHEREAS, According to a 2013 Pennsylvania Economy League
- 2 evaluation of its program covering the period of 1989 through
- 3 2011, BFTP has had an impact on the economy of this Commonwealth
- 4 in excess of \$23.5 billion, generating 51,000 jobs in clients'
- 5 firms and an additional 89,000 jobs as a result of increased
- 6 purchasing and investment by client firms, yielding a total of
- 7 140,000 new jobs attributable to BFTP's work; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This study also found that jobs created by BFTP are
- 9 in industries that pay 36% more than the average nonfarm wage in
- 10 Pennsylvania; and
- WHEREAS, The same study found that from 2007 through 2011,
- 12 the Commonwealth received \$358 million in additional State tax
- 13 receipts as a direct result of BFTP investments in client firms.
- 14 Another \$144 million in State tax receipts flowed from related
- 15 BFTP client services, for a total increase of \$502 million in
- 16 State revenue because of the efforts of BFTP; and
- 17 WHEREAS, New State tax revenue generated because of BFTP
- 18 represents a 3.6 to 1 payback to the Commonwealth on its \$137.7
- 19 million investment in BFTP; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The track record of client success and economic
- 21 development impact has brought repeated and consistent
- 22 recognition to Pennsylvania as a leader in support of innovation
- 23 and entrepreneurship; and
- 24 WHEREAS, In the 2012 Enterprising States report by the United
- 25 States Chamber of Commerce, BFTP was listed among selected
- 26 "types of investment(s) the public and private sectors can make
- 27 now to improve the economy in the future"; and
- WHEREAS, BFTP has become the most recognized and replicated
- 29 technology-based economic development program in the United
- 30 States, with both national and international acknowledgments,

- 1 including awards from the International Economic Development
- 2 Council and the State Science and Technology Institute; and
- 3 WHEREAS, This credibility helps BFTP bring millions of
- 4 dollars to client companies from foundations and the Federal
- 5 Government; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In the last three years, BFTP has secured more than
- 7 \$25 million in awards from these sources to help Pennsylvania
- 8 companies grow; and
- 9 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth continues to benefit tremendously
- 10 from the foresight of its leadership 30 years ago in creating
- 11 BFTP and from the steadfast support of every General Assembly
- 12 and gubernatorial administration since; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 14 30th anniversary of Ben Franklin Technology Partners, designate
- 15 June 3, 2013, as "Ben Franklin Technology Partners Day" in
- 16 Pennsylvania and gratefully acknowledge its consistent success
- 17 in meeting the mission set out in its founding legislation to
- 18 "advance the development of new technologies in the
- 19 Commonwealth."
