- 5 WHEREAS, Statewide recycling in Pennsylvania began in 1988
- 6 with the Municipal Waste Planning Recycling and Waste Reduction
- 7 Act, which requires larger municipalities to recycle; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Today, more than 11.6 million residents, at least
- 9 94% of the State's population, have access to recycling; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 2011, this Commonwealth recycled over 5.85
- 11 million tons of resources; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The materials Pennsylvanians recycle save more than
- 13 150 trillion British thermal units of energy and cut more than
- 14 15 million metric tons of carbon dioxide emissions from the air
- 15 annually; and
- 16 WHEREAS, By converting waste into valuable products,
- 17 recycling creates jobs, contributes feedstock to manufacturing
- 18 and adds significant value to the entire United States economy;

- 2 WHEREAS, Our waste reduction and recycling activities can
- 3 also make a difference in problems such as hazardous waste,
- 4 endangered species, acid rain and the municipal waste crisis;

- 6 WHEREAS, While Pennsylvania has done an outstanding job
- 7 creating and implementing effective recycling programs to date,
- 8 the Commonwealth continues to seek improvements in its recycling
- 9 law; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate 25
- 11 years of successful recycling in this Commonwealth; and be it

- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the people
- 14 of Pennsylvania to continue to excel in their recycling efforts;
- 15 and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
- 17 Department of Environmental Protection to review its recycling
- 18 programs and report any recommendations for improvements to the
- 19 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Environmental
- 20 Resources and Energy Committee within one year of the passage of
- 21 this resolution.
