## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in dispositions
- independent of letters, further providing for payments to
- 4 family and funeral directors.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3101(b) of Title 20 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 3101. Payments to family and funeral directors.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (b) Deposit account. -- Any bank, savings association, savings
- 12 and loan association, building and loan association, credit
- 13 union or other savings organization, at any time after the death
- 14 of a depositor, member or certificate holder, may pay the amount
- 15 on deposit or represented by the certificate, when the total
- 16 standing to the credit of the decedent in that institution does
- 17 not exceed \$3,500, to the spouse, any child, the father or
- 18 mother [or], any sister or brother or any grandchild (preference

- 1 being given in the order named) of the deceased depositor,
- 2 member or certificate holder, provided that a receipted funeral
- 3 bill or an affidavit, executed by a licensed funeral director
- 4 which sets forth that satisfactory arrangements for payment of
- 5 funeral services have been made, is presented. Any bank,
- 6 association, union or other savings organization making such a
- 7 payment shall be released to the same extent as if payment had
- 8 been made to a duly appointed personal representative of the
- 9 decedent and it shall not be required to see to the application
- 10 thereof. Any person to whom payment is made shall be answerable
- 11 therefor to anyone prejudiced by an improper distribution.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
