A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation, further providing for exemptions and special provisions.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby resolves as follows:
Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
That section 2(b) of Article VIII be amended by adding a
clause to read:
§ 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

(b) The General Assembly may, by law:
* * *
(vii) Authorize local taxing authorities to impose a rate of
taxation on residential real property that is different from a
rate of taxation on commercial real property.

1 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 2 3 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 4 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 5 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 6 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 7 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 8 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

9 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this 10 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 11 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 12 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 13 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 14 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 15 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 16 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 18 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 19 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 20 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 21 22 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 23 passed by the General Assembly.
