A RESOLUTION

- Condemning the actions of the Federal Government and the 1

- National Security Agency to engage in illegal domestic surveillance of the citizens of the United States and the 3
- Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. 4
- 5 WHEREAS, Details were made public about the National Security
- 6 Agency (NSA) gathering massive amounts of electronic data
- involving United States citizens; and 7
- 8 WHEREAS, The fourth amendment to the Constitution of the
- 9 United States states, "The right of the people to be secure in
- their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable 10
- searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants 11
- 12 shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or
- 13 affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be
- searched, and the persons or things to be seized."; and 14
- 15 WHEREAS, Publicly available information about the PRISM
- program, and other methods of domestic surveillance, have shown 16
- a complete lack of oversight regarding the issuance of warrants 17
- 18 for search and seizure of personal property; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Our duly elected representatives within the Federal
- 2 Government have taken no steps toward responding to or
- 3 questioning the actions of the NSA; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The actions of domestic spying and broad electronic
- 5 surveillance by the NSA pose a major breach and violation of
- 6 fourth amendment rights guaranteed by the Constitution of the
- 7 United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Declaration of Independence states, "We hold
- 9 these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal,
- 10 that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable
- 11 Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of
- 12 Happiness."; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Declaration of Independence also states, "That
- 14 whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these
- 15 ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish
- 16 it..."; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives believes a broad-based
- 18 dragnet seizure and storage of every individual citizen's
- 19 private electronic data is a violation of the fourth amendment
- 20 to the Constitution of the United States; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Such a violation is intolerable to the people of
- 22 this Commonwealth; and
- 23 WHEREAS, It is the duty and responsibility of our duly
- 24 elected Federal representatives to act appropriately on behalf
- 25 of the people to stop this gross violation of fourth amendment
- 26 rights; and
- 27 WHEREAS, It is the duty and responsibility of officials
- 28 within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to deliberate and, if so
- 29 determined, to echo the people's desire for an end to domestic
- 30 spying; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives condemns the
- 2 actions of the Federal Government and the National Security
- 3 Agency in engaging in illegal domestic surveillance in violation
- 4 of the rights of the citizens of this Commonwealth.
