- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3222(a.1) of Title 58 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3222. Well reporting requirements.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (a.1) Unconventional wells.--Each operator of an
- 11 unconventional well shall file with the department, on a form
- 12 provided by the department, a [semiannual] monthly report
- 13 specifying the amount of production on the most well-specific
- 14 basis available. The initial report under this subsection shall
- 15 be filed by [August 15 and shall include production data from
- 16 the preceding calendar year] February 15, 2014, and specify the
- 17 status of each well. In subsequent reports, only changes in
- 18 status must be reported. Subsequent [semiannual] monthly reports

- 1 shall be filed with the department on or before [February 15 and
- 2 August 15 of each year] the 15th day of each month and shall
- 3 include production data from the preceding reporting period. The
- 4 Commonwealth may utilize reported information in enforcement
- 5 proceedings, in making designations or determinations under
- 6 section 1927-A of The Administrative Code of 1929 or in
- 7 aggregate form for statistical purposes. [Beginning November 1,
- 8 2010, the] The department shall make the reports available on
- 9 its publicly accessible Internet website. Costs incurred by the
- 10 department to comply with the requirements of this subsection
- 11 shall be paid out of the fees collected under section 3211(d)
- 12 (relating to well permits).

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
