AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in magisterial district
3 judges, further providing for jurisdiction and venue.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1515(a)(1) of Title 42 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1515. Jurisdiction and venue.

9 (a) Jurisdiction.--Except as otherwise prescribed by general
10 rule adopted pursuant to section 503 (relating to reassignment
11 of matters), magisterial district judges shall, under procedures
12 prescribed by general rule, have jurisdiction of all of the
13 following matters:

14 (1) Summary offenses, except those arising out of the
15 same episode or transaction involving a delinquent act for
16 which a petition alleging delinquency is filed under Chapter
17 63 (relating to juvenile matters) and those arising out of
18 section 1333 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14),

1 known as the Public School Code of 1949.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
