A RESOLUTION

- 1 Observing September 15 through October 15, 2013, as "Hispanic
- 2 Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth draws its strength from the
- 4 extraordinary diversity of its people and their cultural
- 5 customs; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Hispanics were the earliest European settlers to
- 7 arrive at our great nation, founding settlements in Florida in
- 8 the 1500s; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mexicans established homesteads in the Southwest in
- 10 the 1600s; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Spanish was the first European language spoken in
- 12 the New World; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Hispanic culture includes elements originating in
- 14 Spain, North America, Central America, South America and the
- 15 Caribbean; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Hispanics are the largest minority ethnic group in
- 17 the United States today, with more than 810,000 residing in

- 1 Pennsylvania; and
- WHEREAS, Hispanic Americans make valuable contributions to
- 3 this Commonwealth through business and industry, politics,
- 4 education, the sciences and the arts; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Hispanic Americans share deep family values,
- 6 recognize their obligations to persons who are less fortunate
- 7 and cherish freedom and what it means to be an American; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Hispanic-owned businesses are currently growing at
- 9 three times the rate of the national average; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Throughout our history, Hispanic Americans have
- 11 shown their devotion to our country in their military service;
- 12 and
- WHEREAS, Americans of Hispanic descent have fought in every
- 14 war since our founding and have taken their rightful place as
- 15 heroes in our nation's history; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Today, Americans of Hispanic descent are serving in
- 17 our armed forces with courage and honor, and their efforts help
- 18 make America more secure and bring freedom to people around the
- 19 world; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Month was started in 1968 by
- 21 President Johnson as Hispanic Heritage Week and was expanded to
- 22 one month by President Reagan on September 15, 1988; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The dates for Hispanic Heritage Month were chosen
- 24 because September 15th is the anniversary of independence for
- 25 five Latin American countries: Costa Rica, El Salvador,
- 26 Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua; and
- WHEREAS, September 16th and 18th are the celebrated
- 28 independence days for Mexico and Chile, respectively, and
- 29 finally, Columbus Day, or Dia de La Raza also takes place within
- 30 the 30-day period on October 12th; and

- 1 WHEREAS, To honor the achievements of Hispanic Americans, the
- 2 Congress of the United States, by Public Law 100-402, has
- 3 authorized and requested the President to issue annually a
- 4 proclamation designating September 15 through October 15 as
- 5 National Hispanic Heritage Month; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The month of September 15 through October 15, 2013,
- 7 has been proclaimed Hispanic Heritage Month in Pennsylvania and
- 8 is intended to encourage all citizens to celebrate the value of
- 9 our diversity and the rich culture which makes our Commonwealth
- 10 and our nation so extraordinary; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives observe September
- 12 15 through October 15, 2013, as "Hispanic Heritage Month" in
- 13 Pennsylvania.
