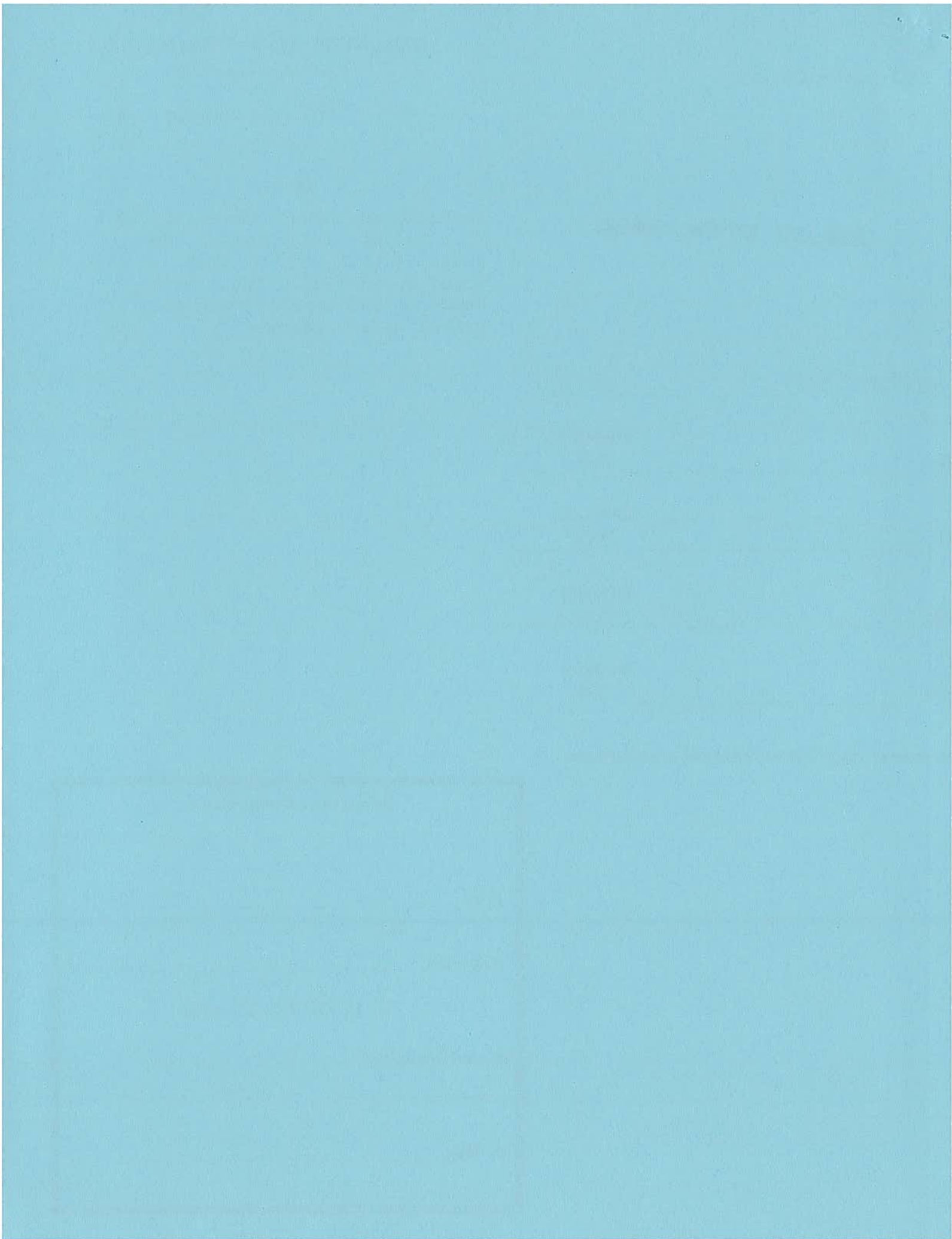

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," in safe schools, providing for
6 private funding; and establishing the School Safety Account.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11 section to read:

12 Section 1302.2-A. Private Funding.--(a) Private foundations
13 and businesses may voluntarily contribute funds to the Treasury
14 Department for deposit into the account established under this
15 section.

16 (b) The School Safety Account is hereby established as a
17 restricted account within the General Fund. The proceeds of the
18 funds received by private foundations and businesses under
19 subsection (a) shall be deposited into the account. The money in

1 the account shall be continually appropriated, upon approval of
2 the Governor, to the Department of Education for the exclusive
3 use by the Office for Safe Schools of carrying out its powers
4 and duties under section 1302-A.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
