- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for
- person with disability plate and placard; and, in rules of
- the road in general, further providing for additional parking
- 5 regulations.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1338(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard.
- 11 * * *
- 12 (d) Penalty.--Any person violating this section commits a
- 13 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 14 a fine [of not more than \$100.] as follows:
- 15 (1) Two hundred fifty dollars for a first offense.
- 16 (2) Five hundred dollars for a second offense.
- 17 (3) Seven hundred fifty dollars for a third or
- 18 <u>subsequent offense.</u>
- 19 * * *

- Section 2. Section 3354(d)(3)(i) and (f) of Title 75 are
- 2 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
- 3 read:
- 4 § 3354. Additional parking regulations.
- 5 * * *
- 6 (d) Person with a disability and disabled veterans.--
- 7 * * *
- 8 (3) (i) Except for persons parking vehicles lawfully
- 9 bearing a person with a disability or severely disabled
- veteran registration plate or displaying a person with a
- disability or severely disabled veteran parking placard when
- such vehicles are being operated by or for the transportation
- of a person with a disability or a severely disabled veteran,
- 14 no person shall park a vehicle on public or private property
- reserved for a person with a disability or severely disabled
- veteran which property has been so posted in accordance with
- 17 departmental regulations. Regulations shall require that
- 18 parking spaces designated with an international symbol for
- 19 access for persons with disabilities on a sign are posted
- with a sign stating the penalty amount indicated in
- subsection (f) and that vehicles in violation of the
- 22 subsection may be towed and require that signs be replaced
- 23 when they become either obsolete or missing with all costs to
- replace the necessary signs to be borne by the persons
- 25 responsible for signing the particular location. The sign
- shall state, in effect, if you see a vehicle parking in this
- 27 space that does not bear a person with a disability or
- 28 <u>severely disabled veteran registration plate or displaying a</u>
- 29 person with a disability or severely disabled veteran parking
- 30 placard, call the toll-free telephone number established or

- designated under subsection (d.1). The absence of a sign
- 2 stating the penalty amount at parking spaces designated with
- an international symbol for access for persons with
- 4 disabilities shall not preclude the enforcement of this
- subsection. A vehicle which is unlawfully parked in a
- 6 designated person with a disability parking area may be
- 7 removed from that area by towing and may be reclaimed by the
- 8 vehicle owner upon payment of the towing costs. A vehicle may
- 9 only be towed under this paragraph if the parking space is
- 10 posted with a sign indicating that vehicles in violation of
- 11 this section may be towed.
- 12 * * *
- 13 (d.1) Hotline.--The department shall establish or designate
- 14 a toll-free telephone number to report violations under
- 15 subsection (e).
- 16 * * *
- 17 (f) Penalty.--A person violating subsection (a), (b) or (d)
- 18 (1) is quilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction,
- 19 be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15. A person
- 20 violating subsection (d)(2) or (3) or (e) is guilty of a summary
- 21 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine
- 22 [of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200.] as follows:
- 23 (1) Two hundred fifty dollars for a first offense.
- 24 (2) Five hundred dollars for a second offense.
- 25 (3) Seven hundred fifty dollars for a third or
- 26 <u>subsequent offense.</u>
- 27 If a person is convicted under subsection (d)(2) or (3) in the
- 28 absence of a sign stating the penalty amount, the fine imposed
- 29 may not exceed \$50.
- 30 * * *

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
