AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act to preserve and improve the purity of the 2 waters of the Commonwealth for the protection of public 3 health, animal and aquatic life, and for industrial 4 consumption, and recreation; empowering and directing the 5 creation of indebtedness or the issuing of non-debt revenue 6 bonds by political subdivisions to provide works to abate 7 pollution; providing protection of water supply and water 8 quality; providing for the jurisdiction of courts in the enforcement thereof; providing additional remedies for abating pollution of waters; imposing certain penalties; 9 10 11 repealing certain acts; regulating discharges of sewage and 12 industrial wastes; regulating the operation of mines and 13 regulating the impact of mining upon water quality, supply 14 and quantity; placing responsibilities upon landowners and 15 land occupiers and to maintain primary jurisdiction over 16 surface coal mining in Pennsylvania," further providing for 17 powers and duties of department. 18
- 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of June 22, 1937
- 22 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law, amended
- 23 October 10, 1980 (P.L.894, No.157), is amended and the section
- 24 is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 25 Section 5. Powers and Duties. -- (a) [The] Subject to the

- 1 provisions of subsection (c), the department, in adopting rules
- 2 and regulations, in establishing policy and priorities, in
- 3 issuing orders or permits, and in taking any other action
- 4 pursuant to this act, shall, in the exercise of sound judgment
- 5 and discretion, and for the purpose of implementing the
- 6 declaration of policy set forth in section 4 of this act,
- 7 consider, where applicable, the following:
- 8 (1) Water quality management and pollution control in the
- 9 watershed as a whole;
- 10 (2) The present and possible future uses of particular
- 11 waters;
- 12 (3) The feasibility of combined or joint treatment
- 13 facilities;
- 14 (4) The state of scientific and technological knowledge;
- 15 (5) The immediate and long-range economic impact upon the
- 16 Commonwealth and its citizens.
- 17 * * *
- (c) Fish hatcheries in a county of the fifth, sixth, seventh
- 19 or eighth class in operation, continuously or otherwise, prior
- 20 to January 1, 1993, shall be exempt from the provisions of 25
- 21 Pa. Code Ch. 93 (relating to water quality standards).
- 22 Section 2. Any and all regulations are abrogated to the
- 23 extent of any inconsistency with this act.
- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
