A RESOLUTION

Urging the Pennsylvania Game Commission to explore the 1 possibility of opening the rifle hunting season for white-2 tailed deer in Pennsylvania on the Saturday directly 3 following Thanksgiving. 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Game Commission is the agency with 5 ultimate management authority for white-tailed deer; and 6 WHEREAS, According to the Pennsylvania Game Commission, an 7 estimated 343,110 deer were harvested during the 2012-2013 deer 8 hunting seasons, with 225,220 being taken during the regular 9 10 rifle deer season; and WHEREAS, Deer hunting is one of this Commonwealth's most 11 valued traditions and has a significant economic impact on this 12 13 Commonwealth; and WHEREAS, Hunters have less available time to hunt due to the 14 ever-increasing demands of work, family and other obligations; 15 16 and WHEREAS, For many hunters, taking a day off work or missing 17 other obligations in order to hunt on the traditional Monday 18

1 start to the season can create additional financial burden 2 during challenging economic times; and

3 WHEREAS, Opening the regular rifle deer season on the 4 Saturday following Thanksgiving could help generate more 5 interest and participation in deer hunting in this Commonwealth 6 due to the additional opportunity it would provide; therefore be 7 it 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the 9 Pennsylvania Game Commission to explore the possibility of 10 opening the rifle deer hunting season on the Saturday directly 11 following Thanksgiving; and be it further 12 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the
