AN ACT

- 1 Providing for an application fee reduction for high school
- seniors applying to State-owned institutions; and imposing
- duties on the State System of Higher Education.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the College
- 8 "Apportunity" Act.
- 9 Section 2. Legislative intent.
- 10 It is the intent of the General Assembly to facilitate the
- 11 purpose of the State System of Higher Education of providing
- 12 high quality education at the lowest possible cost to students.
- 13 Specifically, this act seeks to decrease the barriers high
- 14 school seniors, especially those who aspire to be first-
- 15 generation college students or those who would not otherwise be
- 16 able to afford application fees, face in applying to colleges.
- 17 Section 3. Definitions.
- The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

- 1 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "PASSHE." The State System of Higher Education.
- 4 "State-owned institution." An institution that is part of
- 5 the State System of Higher Education pursuant to Article XX-A of
- 6 the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public
- 7 School Code of 1949.
- 8 Section 4. Application fee discount.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- On the third Thursday of October of each
- 10 year, to be known as "College 'Apportunity' Day," every high
- 11 school in this Commonwealth shall provide high school seniors
- 12 with a discount code for the application fee to apply for
- 13 admission to any or all State-owned institutions. The high
- 14 school senior shall write the code on the promotional code
- 15 section of the application for admission. The code shall
- 16 discount the application fee so that the fee for each
- 17 application is \$5.
- 18 (b) Discount code.--PASSHE shall provide all high schools
- 19 within this Commonwealth with the universal discount code that
- 20 shall allow high school seniors to apply to State-owned
- 21 institutions for the amount provided under subsection (a).
- (c) Application. -- The following shall apply:
- 23 (1) Every State-owned institution shall revise its
- 24 application for admission so that it contains a promotional
- 25 code section.
- 26 (2) Upon receiving an application for admission
- containing the universal discount code provided by PASSHE, a
- 28 State-owned institution shall process the application if the
- 29 application contains the application fee required under
- 30 subsection (a).

- 1 (d) Advertisement.--Beginning on October 1 of each year,
- 2 PASSHE shall advertise "College 'Apportunity' Day" to high
- 3 school seniors across this Commonwealth. PASHHE may promulgate
- 4 regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of this
- 5 subsection.
- 6 (e) Admission requirements.--The application fee discount
- 7 provided under this section shall not be construed to waive any
- 8 admission requirements of State-owned institutions.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
