- and is celebrated annually in Greece on March 25; and
- WHEREAS, In 1821, the Greek Commander-in-Chief Petros 13
- Mavromichalis, a founder of the modern Greek state, remarked to L4 .5
- citizens of the United States that "it is in your land that 6
- liberty has fixed her abode and . . . in imitating you, we shall 7
- imitate our ancestors and be thought worthy of them if we 8
- succeed in resembling you"; and
