## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, providing for academic standards and
- 6 testing commission.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 123. Academic Standards and Testing Commission.~-(a)</u>
- 13 The State Board shall establish an Academic Standards and
- 14 Testing Commission to study and offer recommendations to the
- 15 State Board concerning the Commonwealth's academic standards and
- 16 assessments as provided for in this section.
- 17 (b) (1) Not earlier than January 1, 2017, but not later
- 18 than February 1, 2017, the State Board shall appoint the members
- 19 of the commission, which shall include representatives of the

- 1 State Board, the department, business, school districts, charter
- 2 schools, cyber charter schools, regional charter schools, area
- 3 vocational-technical schools, intermediate units, the State
- 4 System of Higher Education, State-related universities,
- 5 <u>community colleges</u>, <u>independent colleges and universities and</u>
- 6 the United States Armed Forces.
- 7 (2) The commission shall appoint a member to serve as chair
- 8 of the commission.
- 9 (3) After appointing the commission pursuant to paragraph
- 10 (1), the State Board shall convene the first meeting of the
- 11 commission by March 1, 2017. The commission shall hold future
- 12 meetings at the call of the chair.
- 13 (4) Members of the commission shall not receive compensation
- 14 for their services, but shall be reimbursed for all necessary
- 15 travel and other reasonable expenses incurred in connection with
- 16 the performance of their duties as members of the commission.
- 17 (5) The department shall provide administrative support,
- 18 meeting space and any other assistance required by the
- 19 commission to carry out its duties under this section. The
- 20 <u>department shall also provide the commission and the State Board</u>
- 21 with data, research and other information upon request by the
- 22 commission or the State Board.
- 23 (c) The commission shall have the following powers and
- 24 <u>duties:</u>
- 25 (1) Review and make findings and recommendations related to
- 26 the Commonwealth's academic standards and assessments.
- 27 (2) Consult with and utilize experts to assist the
- 28 <u>commission in carrying out its duties under this section.</u>
- 29 (3) Hold public hearings.
- 30 (4) Receive input from interested parties.

- 1 (5) Review and consider academic standards and assessments
- 2 utilized throughout the United States.
- 3 (6) Within two (2) years after the commission's first
- 4 meeting, issue a report of its findings and recommendations to
- 5 the Governor, the President pro tempore of the Senate, the
- 6 Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the Senate, the Education
- 7 Committee of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
- 8 Representatives, the Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the
- 9 House of Representatives, the Education Committee of the House
- 10 of Representatives, the Secretary of Education and the State
- 11 Board.
- 12 (d) Upon receipt of the report required under subsection (c)
- 13 (6), the State Board shall consider the report and promulgate
- 14 regulations necessary to implement the recommendations pursuant
- 15 to the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the
- 16 <u>"Regulatory Review Act."</u>
- (e) Every five (5) years following issuance of the
- 18 commission's report under subsection (c)(6), the commission
- 19 shall be reconstituted in accordance with subsection (b), shall
- 20 meet and hold public hearings to review the operation of the
- 21 Commonwealth's academic standards and assessments, shall make a
- 22 <u>further report and shall issue the report to the recipients</u>
- 23 <u>listed in subsection (c)(6). When in receipt of a further report</u>
- 24 recommending changes to the Commonwealth's academic standards
- 25 and assessments, the State Board shall consider the report and
- 26 promulgate regulations necessary to implement the
- 27 recommendations pursuant to the "Regulatory Review Act."
- 28 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 29 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 30 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>

- 1 "Academic standards." The academic standards established
- 2 pursuant to 22 Pa. Code Chapter 4 (relating to academic
- 3 standards and assessment).
- 4 "Assessment." The Pennsylvania System of School Assessment
- 5 test, the Keystone Exam or another test established by the State
- 6 Board pursuant to 22 Pa. Code § 4.51(f) (relating to State
- 7 <u>assessment system).</u>
- 8 "Commission." The Academic Standards and Testing Commission
- 9 <u>established under this section</u>.
- 10 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 <u>"State Board." The State Board of Education.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
