2 Annual National Public Works Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The American Public Works Association has 29,000  
4 members and, since 1960, has sponsored National Public Works  
5 Week; and

6 WHEREAS, National Public Works Week is designed to educate  
7 communities and their leaders on the importance of our nation's  
8 infrastructure and public works services; and

9 WHEREAS, Public works are essential to the quality of life of  
10 all citizens in this Commonwealth and National Public Works Week  
11 affirms the contributions of public works professionals to this  
12 Commonwealth; and

13 WHEREAS, National Public Works Week serves as a time to  
14 recognize the contributions of public works professionals who  
15 design, build, plan, operate and maintain the transportation,  
16 water supply, water treatment and solid waste disposal systems,  
17 public buildings and other structures and facilities essential

2 WHEREAS, Public works professionals exhibit dedication and  
3 expertise at all levels of government and the private sector,  
4 and are a capital investment in the economic growth, development
