- 14 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Joshua M. Martino was a Boy Scout,
- 15 traveled to Europe in 2011 as a Student Ambassador with People
- 16 to People and enjoyed hunting, fishing, camping, boating,
- 17 shooting and playing drums; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Joshua M. Martino volunteered in
- 19 Europe by cleaning waterways, working with individuals with

- 1 special needs and building a habitat for wildlife, volunteered
- 2 with the Special Olympics and was a volunteer firefighter; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Joshua M. Martino had a passion for
- 4 health and well-being, lived life to its fullest, loved
- 5 challenges and new experiences and wanted to be a Marine since
- 6 the age of eight because he could not stand by and let anything

- 8 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Joshua M. Martino joined the United
- 9 States Marine Corps on July 10, 2012, completed recruit training
- 10 at Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, South Carolina,

- 12 where he earned the Military Occupational Specialty of 0341,
- 13 Mortarman, joined the 1st Battalion, 9th Marines, Alpha Company
- 14 in December 2012, was an ammunition bearer during his time in
- 15 Weapons Platoon and was slated for his first deployment to
- 16 Afghanistan in October 2013; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Joshua M. Martino was awarded the
- 18 National Defense Service Medal and the Global War on Terrorism
- 19 Service Medal and was posthumously promoted to the rank of Lance
