AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled 1 "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize 2 and bargain collectively through selected representatives; 3 defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit 4 organizations and institutions; providing compulsory 5 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes 6 7 for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of 8 collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and 9 employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public 10 employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; 11 providing penalties for violations; and establishing 12 procedures for implementation, "barring strikes by employees 13 of the Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority. 14

- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 16 hereby enacts as follows:
- 17 Section 1. Section 1001 of the act of July 23, 1970
- 18 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, is
- 19 amended to read:
- 20 Section 1001. Strikes by employes of the Southeastern
- 21 Pennsylvania Transportation Authority (SEPTA), guards at prisons
- 22 or mental hospitals, or employes directly involved with and
- 23 necessary to the functioning of the courts of this Commonwealth

- 1 are prohibited at any time. If a strike occurs the public
- 2 employer shall forthwith initiate in the court of common pleas
- 3 of the jurisdiction where the strike occurs, an action for
- 4 appropriate equitable relief including but not limited to
- 5 injunctions. If the strike involves Commonwealth employes, the
- 6 chief legal officer of the public employer or the Attorney
- 7 General where required by law shall institute an action for
- 8 equitable relief, either in the court of common pleas of the
- 9 jurisdiction where the strike has occurred or the Commonwealth
- 10 Court.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
