AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556, No.101), entitled 1 "An act providing for planning for the processing and 2 disposal of municipal waste; requiring counties to submit 3 plans for municipal waste management systems within their 4 5 boundaries; authorizing grants to counties and municipalities for planning, resource recovery and recycling; imposing and 6 collecting fees; establishing certain rights for host 7 municipalities; requiring municipalities to implement 8 recycling programs; requiring Commonwealth agencies to 9 procure recycled materials; imposing duties; granting powers 10 to counties and municipalities; authorizing the Environmental 11 Quality Board to adopt regulations; authorizing the 12 Department of Environmental Resources to implement this act; 13 providing remedies; prescribing penalties; establishing a 14 fund; and making repeals, " providing for municipal fees. 15 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- hereby enacts as follows: 17
- The act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556, No.101), known 18 Section 1.
- 19 as the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction
- Act, is amended by adding a section to read: 20
- Section 708. Municipal fees. 21
- (a) Fees.--Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 22
- contrary, a municipality may impose and collect reasonable and 23
- 24 necessary fees to cover the cost of providing a recycling

- 1 program to a person in the municipality.
- 2 (b) Prior fees.--A municipality which has charged a fee for
- 3 recycling under this act, prior to the effective date of this
- 4 section, shall be deemed to have been performing a valid
- 5 exercise of the powers of the municipality.
- 6 Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
- 7 as they are inconsistent with this act.
- 8 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
