- is amended by adding a section to read: 8
- Section 7104. Presumption of law for civil and administrative 9
- proceedings relating to seismic testing. 10
- (a) Presumption. -- It shall be a rebuttable presumption of 11
- law that a person conducting seismic testing is liable and 12
- responsible for all damage within 1,000 feet of where the 13
- seismic testing was conducted without proof of fault, negligence 14
- or causation. In order for the presumption to apply, a claim for 15
- damage must arise or be made within 90 days of the completion of 16
- seismic testing. 17
- (b) Defenses. -- In order to overcome the presumption of 18

- 1 liability established in subsection (a), the person conducting
- 2 seismic testing must affirmatively prove, by clear and
- 3 convincing evidence, one of the following:
- 4 (1) The damages existed prior to the seismic testing.
- 5 (2) The damage was not within 1,000 feet of the seismic
- 6 <u>testing.</u>
- 7 (3) The damages occurred as a result of some cause other
- 8 than the seismic testing.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
