- Amending the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), 1
- entitled "An act prohibiting unfair methods of competition 2
- and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of 3

- any trade or commerce, giving the Attorney General and District Attorneys certain powers and duties and providing 5
- penalties, " further providing for civil penalties. 6
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 8(b) of the act of December 17, 1968
- 10 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and
- Consumer Protection Law, reenacted and amended November 24, 1976 11
- (P.L.1166, No.260) and amended December 4, 1996 (P.L.906, 12
- No.146), is amended to read: 13
- Section 8. Civil Penalties. -- * * * 14
- In any action brought under section 4 of this act, if 15 (b)
- the court finds that a person, firm or corporation is wilfully 16
- using or has wilfully used a method, act or practice declared 17
- unlawful by section 3 of this act, the Attorney General or the 18
- 19 appropriate District Attorney, acting in the name of the

- 1 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, may recover, on behalf of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, a civil penalty of not exceeding
- 3 [one] ten thousand dollars [(\$1,000)] (\$10,000) per violation,
- 4 which civil penalty shall be in addition to other relief which
- 5 may be granted under sections 4 and 4.1 of this act. Where the
- 6 victim of the wilful use of a method, act or practice declared
- 7 unlawful by section 3 of this act is sixty years of age or
- 8 older, the civil penalty shall not exceed [three] fifteen
- 9 thousand dollars [(\$3,000)] (\$15,000) per violation, which
- 10 penalty shall be in addition to other relief which may be
- 11 granted under sections 2 and 4.1 of this act.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
