A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of September 2014 as "Ovarian Cancer
- 2 Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every woman is at risk for ovarian cancer regardless
- 4 of age, heritage or medical history; and
- 5 WHEREAS, According to the American Cancer Society, a woman's
- 6 risk of being diagnosed with ovarian cancer during her lifetime
- 7 is 1 in 73; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer is the ninth most common cancer among
- 9 women and the fifth leading cause of cancer death among women;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, Approximately one-half of the women with ovarian
- 12 cancer are 63 years of age or older; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society estimates that there
- 14 will be approximately 21,980 new cases of ovarian cancer in the
- 15 United States in 2014 and that 14,270 women will die from
- 16 ovarian cancer in 2014; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Approximately one-fifth of ovarian cancers are found

- 1 at an early stage; and
- WHEREAS, Early detection improves the chances of survival;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Nine out of ten women treated for early ovarian
- 5 cancer will live longer than five years after the cancer is
- 6 found; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Ovarian cancer awareness and education are important
- 8 factors in diagnosis and treatment; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 10 month of September 2014 as "Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month" in
- 11 Pennsylvania.
