## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for organization of the Pennsylvania Game Commission.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 301(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 301. Organization of commission.
9	* * *
10	(c) Term of office and compensation
11	(1) [The members] <u>A member</u> of the commission shall hold
12	office for <u>not more than two</u> terms of [eight] <u>four</u> years
13	each, subject to Senate confirmation pursuant to law for each
14	term, and may continue to hold office for a period of time
15	not to exceed [six] <u>12</u> months or until a successor is

appointed and qualified, whichever occurs first. <u>Thereafter</u>,
<u>the person shall be ineligible to hold that office</u>.

3 (2) A member of the commission appointed to fill a 4 vacancy for a period of [four] <u>two</u> years or less may be 5 eligible for appointment to a full [eight-year] <u>four-year</u> 6 term. [A member of the commission who serves a full eight-7 year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more than four 8 years shall not be eligible for reappointment to the 9 commission until a period of eight years expires.]

10 <u>(3)</u> Commissioners shall receive no compensation for 11 their services, but may be reimbursed for travel expenses. 12 \* \* \*

Section 2. The amendment of 34 Pa.C.S. § 301(c) shall apply to members of the commission appointed on or after the effective date of this section.

16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
