

## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in professional and occupational  
3 licenses, further providing for definitions and for retention  
4 and certification.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 7501 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 7501. [Definition] Definitions.

10 [As used in this chapter, the word "person" means any] The  
11 following words and phrases when used in this chapter shall have  
12 the meanings given to them in this section unless the context  
13 clearly indicates otherwise:

14 "Person." An individual, whether male or female, who may,  
15 have been, is now or may hereafter become engaged in the service  
16 of the United States of America or its allies as a member of the  
17 armed forces, or of the merchant marine thereof, or of any  
18 auxiliary thereof subject to military discipline.

1 "Veteran." An individual who served on active duty in the  
2 armed forces and who has been discharged or released from the  
3 service under conditions other than dishonorable.

4 Section 2. Section 7502(b) of Title 51 is amended and the  
5 section is amended by adding a subsection to read:

6 § 7502. Retention of licenses and certifications of persons  
7 entering military service.

9 (b) Renewal of license or certification following  
10 discharge.-- [Any such person, upon presentation of a discharge  
11 from such service within one year from date thereof, and upon  
12 payment of the fee prescribed by law for the current renewal  
13 period only, shall be entitled to a renewal of his or her  
14 license, certification or registration in the same manner as  
15 though such renewal had been made prior to the expiration of his  
16 or her last preceding renewal, as though all intermediate  
17 renewal fees had been paid and as though all continuing  
18 education or in-service training requirements have been  
19 satisfied.] A person shall, after presentation of a discharge  
20 from service described under subsection (a) within one year from  
21 the date of discharge and payment of the fee prescribed by law  
22 for the current renewal period only, be entitled to a renewal of  
23 his or her license, certification or registration in the same  
24 manner as though:

25 (1) The renewal had been made prior to the expiration of  
26 his or her last preceding renewal.

27 (2) All intermediate renewal fees had been paid.

28 (3) All continuing education or in-service training  
29 requirements have been satisfied.

30 (c) Exemptions.--A veteran's military service, education,

1 training and service experience shall be taken into  
2 consideration by the entities listed under subsection (a) to  
3 determine whether a licensing or certification requirement has  
4 been met by or can otherwise be waived by reason of that  
5 military service, education, training or experience. The veteran  
6 shall only be required to meet a licensing or certification  
7 requirement which has not been met by or waived under this  
8 subsection.

9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
