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AN ACT

Amending the act of June 2, 1937 (P.L.1198, No.308), entitled 1 "An act relating to employes and organizations thereof; 2 defining labor disputes; prescribing the procedure by which 3 and the conditions under which injunctions may be granted in 4 such disputes, and the scope thereof; declaring certain 5 undertakings and promises between employers and employes 6 contrary to public policy and void; prescribing the nature of 7 proof necessary in actions arising out of labor disputes 8 against persons or associations; prescribing the terms and 9 conditions for bonds to be furnished prior to the issuance of 10 injunctions; prescribing the procedure in case of appeal from 11 granting injunctions; limiting the duration of temporary and 12 permanent injunctions in case of labor disputes; and 13 providing for the payment of costs; and repealing all acts or 14 parts of acts inconsistent herewith, providing for award of 15 reasonable costs, expenses and attorney fees in enforcement 16 proceedings. 17

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- 19 hereby enacts as follows:
- 20 Section 1. The act of June 2, 1937 (P.L.1198, No.308), known

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 21 as the Labor Anti-Injunction Act, is amended by adding a section
- 22 to read:

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- 23 Section 15.1. A party that fails to comply with a
- 24 restraining order or temporary or permanent injunction granted
- 25 in a case involving or growing out of a labor dispute shall be

- 1 ordered, upon motion submitted by another party to the court for
- 2 enforcement of the order or injunction and granting of the
- 3 motion by the court, to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and
- 4 attorney fees incurred by the moving party on the motion.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
