Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, funds from licensed gaming entities located within a county of the first class shall not be distributed outside of a county of the first class. The [first \$5,000,000 of the] total amount distributed annually to the county of the first class under this part shall be distributed to the Philadelphia School District.
