AN ACT

1 Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in revenues relating to gaming, further providing
3 for establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine
4 revenue distribution.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1403(c)(2)(iii)(A) of Title 4 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 1403. Establishment of State Gaming Fund and net slot machine
10 revenue distribution.

12 (c) Transfers and distributions.--The department shall:

13 * * *

14 (2) From the local share assessment established in
15 subsection (b), make quarterly distributions among the
16 counties hosting a licensed facility in accordance with the
17 following schedule:

18 * * *

1 (iii) If the facility is a Category 2 licensed
2 facility and if the county in which the licensed facility
3 is located is:

4 (A) A county of the first class: 4% of the
5 gross terminal revenue to the county hosting the
6 licensed facility from each such licensed facility.
7 Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary,
8 funds from licensed gaming entities located within a
9 county of the first class shall not be distributed
10 outside of a county of the first class. The [first
11 \$5,000,000 of the] total amount distributed annually
12 to the county of the first class under this part
13 shall be distributed to the Philadelphia School
14 District.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
