Amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for industrial hemp research; imposing powers and duties on the Department of Agriculture and the

Legislative Reference Bureau; abrogating a regulation; and

making a related repeal.

- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Title 3 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
- 9 is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 19 § 701. Scope.

- 1 This chapter relates to industrial hemp research.
- 2 § 702. Definitions.
- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 6 <u>"Agricultural pilot program."</u> A pilot program to study the
- 7 growth, cultivation or marketing of industrial hemp.
- 8 <u>"Department." The Department of Agriculture of the</u>
- 9 Commonwealth.
- 10 "Industrial hemp." The plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part
- 11 of the plant, whether growing or not, with a delta-9
- 12 <u>tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3% on a</u>
- 13 <u>dry-weight basis.</u>
- 14 "Institution of higher education." As defined by section 101
- of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (Public Law 89-329, 20
- 16 U.S.C. § 1001).
- "Secretary." The Secretary of Agriculture of the
- 18 <u>Commonwealth</u>.
- 19 § 703. Administration.
- 20 (a) Department.--The department has the following duties:
- 21 (1) Implement this chapter.
- 22 (2) Establish a certification and registration program
- 23 <u>under section 704(b)(2) (relating to growth and cultivation)</u>
- 24 and, when the program is operative, transmit notice of that
- 25 <u>fact to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in</u>
- the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 27 (b) Regulations.--The department may promulgate regulations
- 28 to implement this chapter.
- 29 (c) Secretary.--If the secretary determines that a Federal
- 30 agency is authorized to regulate industrial hemp, the secretary

- 1 shall transmit notice of that authorization to the bureau for
- 2 publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 3 § 704. Growth and cultivation.
- 4 (a) Authorization. -- Notwithstanding section 4(1)(vii)1 of
- 5 the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The
- 6 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, industrial
- 7 hemp may be grown or cultivated by the department or an
- 8 institution of higher education for the purposes of research
- 9 conducted under an agricultural pilot program in compliance with
- 10 subsection (b).
- 11 (b) Manner.--Industrial hemp shall be grown or cultivated in
- 12 a manner that complies with all of the following:
- 13 (1) Ensures that only institutions of higher education
- and the department are used to grow or cultivate industrial
- $15 \quad \underline{\text{hemp.}}$
- 16 (2) Requires that sites used for growing or cultivating
- 17 industrial hemp be certified by and registered with the
- 18 department.
- 19 § 705. Abrogation of regulation.
- The provisions of 7 Pa. Code § 110.1(1) (relating to noxious
- 21 weed control list) are abrogated.
- 22 § 706. Expiration.
- 23 This chapter shall expire upon publication of the notice
- 24 under section 703(c) (relating to administration).
- 25 Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
- 26 (1) The General Assembly finds and declares that the
- 27 repeal under paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the
- addition of 3 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7.
- 29 (2) Section 8(1) of the act of April 7, 1982 (P.L.228,
- No.74), known as the Noxious Weed Control Law, is repealed.

1	Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
2	(1) The following provisions shall take effect
3	immediately:
4	(i) The addition of 3 Pa.C.S. § 703.
5	(ii) Section 2(1) of this act.
6	(iii) This section.
7	(2) The remainder of this act shall take effect upon

publication of the notice under 3 Pa.C.S. § 703(a)(2).
