- 1 Amending the act of November 24, 1998 (P.L.882, No.111),
- entitled "An act providing for victims' rights; imposing

- 14 (a) Duty of Department of Revenue. -- In the case of any
- 15 taxpayer due to receive a refund under section 346 of the act of
- 16 March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of
- 17 1971, the Department of Revenue shall deduct from the refund the
- 18 amount of any court-ordered obligation arising from a criminal
- 19 prosecution or proceeding, pay the amount deducted to the clerk
- 20 of court for the county in which the order was entered and pay

- 1 any amount remaining to the taxpayer.
- 2 (b) Priority. -- A deduction under subsection (a) shall be
- 3 given priority after any deduction for delinquent Pennsylvania

- 6 (c) Administrative fee. -- The Department of Revenue may
