- 5 WHEREAS, Jose Molina was born and raised in Puerto Rico and
- 6 migrated to the City of Philadelphia in 1989; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Molina graduated from Kutztown University with a
- 8 bachelor of science degree in business administration and a
- 9 master of business administration degree in human resources
- 10 management and services; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mr. Molina began his exemplary public service career
- 12 with the Department of Human Services of the Commonwealth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, After 10 years with the Department of Human
- 14 Services, Mr. Molina worked at Kutztown University for 14 years,
- 15 most recently as the Director for Community Engagement and
- 16 Government Affairs; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In this position, Mr. Molina was involved with
- 18 various Latino organizations, including Berks and Lehigh Latino

- 1 Chambers of Commerce and dozens of community organizations,
- 2 school districts and charter schools; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Molina has been active in the Latino community
- 4 for 20 years, most notably as the chair of the Northeast Region
- 5 for the Pennsylvania Statewide Latino Coalition, president of
- 6 the Latino Leadership Alliance of the Lehigh Valley, president
- 7 and vice president of the Kutztown University Latino Caucus,
- 8 board member of the Hispanic American Organization and the
- 9 Allentown Puerto Rican Parade; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In recognition of his public and community service,
- 11 Mr. Molina has received numerous distinctions and honors,
- 12 including appointment as the Latino Outreach Coordinator for the
- 13 House of Representatives in 2007 and selection as the 2008
- 14 Latino of the Year by the Allentown branch of the Puerto Rican
- 15 Cultural Alliance and the 2014 Bert Daday Community Service
- 16 Award recipient by the Hispanic American Organization; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Molina was appointed to former Governor Tom
- 18 Corbett's transition committees for the Department of Human
- 19 Services and the Department of Community and Economic
- 20 Development; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Mr. Molina was involved with President Barack
- 22 Obama's efforts to establish an Advisory Commission on
- 23 Educational Excellence for Hispanics; and
- 24 WHEREAS, In March 2015, Governor Tom Wolf appointed Mr.
- 25 Molina as the Executive Director of the Governor's Advisory
- 26 Commission on Latino Affairs, the Commonwealth's advocacy agency
- 27 for Latinos as reestablished by the Governor on August 4, 2015;

- 29 WHEREAS, The month of September 15 through October 15 is
- 30 annually observed as "Hispanic Heritage Month" in this
