

## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled  
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,  
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,  
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating  
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;  
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,  
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;  
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,  
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and  
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to  
11 elections," in dates of elections and primaries and special  
12 elections, providing for change of date for religious  
13 holidays.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known  
17 as the Pennsylvania Election Code, is amended by adding a  
18 section to read:

19 Section 606. Change of Date; Religious Holidays.--In any  
20 year during which a general election, municipal election or  
21 municipal primary election would otherwise occur on a date that  
22 is a religious holiday, the date of such election as prescribed  
23 by this act shall be on the Tuesday immediately following such

1 religious holiday.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
