Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for 2 qualifications to register, for government agencies and for 3 preparation and distribution of applications. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Sections 1301(a), 1325(b)(4) and 1327(a)(4)(iii) 7 Section 1. and (b)(1) of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes 8 are amended to read: 9 § 1301. Qualifications to register. 10 11 (a) Eligibility.--An individual who will be at least 18 12 years of age on the day of the next election, who has been a 13 citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the next election and who has resided in this Commonwealth and the 14 election district where the individual offers to vote for at 15 least 30 days prior to the next ensuing election [and has not 16 been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a 17 felony within the last five years) shall be eligible to register 18

5 (b) Forms.--An agency designated in subsection (a) shall 6 provide a form for office visits or, if the agency provides 7 services to persons with disabilities, for home visits which 8 contains all of the following:

(4) The statement "In order to be qualified to register 10 to vote, you must be at least 18 years of age on the day of 11 the next election, and you must have been a citizen of the 12 13 United States for at least one month prior to the next election and have resided in Pennsylvania and the election 14 district where you plan to vote for at least 30 days prior to 15 16 the next election[, and you must not have been confined in a penal institution for a conviction of a felony within the 17 last five years]." 18

20 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.

21 (a) Form.--

(4) A voter registration application shall be printed on 23 stock of good quality and shall be of suitable uniform size. 24 Nothing in this part shall prohibit the design and use of an 25 electronic voter registration application which includes the 26 applicant's digitized or electronic signature. The 27 registration application shall contain the following 28 29 information; however, the information may be provided on a separate form for voter registration made under section 1323 30

3 (iii) Notice that the applicant must be a citizen of the United States for at least one month prior to the 4 next election and a resident of this Commonwealth and the 5 6 election district for at least 30 days and must be at least 18 years of age by the day of the next ensuing 7 election [and has not been confined in a penal 8 institution for a conviction of a felony within the last 9 10 five years]. The notice required in this subparagraph 11 shall be in print identical to the declaration under subsection (b). 12

(1) The official voter registration application shall
contain a registration declaration. On the declaration, the
applicant shall state all of the following:

18 (i) The applicant has been a citizen of the United

21 applicant shall be at least 18 years of age.

(iii) On the day of the next ensuing election, the
applicant shall have resided in this Commonwealth and in
the election district for at least 30 days.

(v) The applicant is legally qualified to vote.
