

AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," in services for the blind
21 and visually impaired, further providing for definitions and
22 for business enterprises, equipment, leases, repayment.

23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
24 hereby enacts as follows:

25 Section 1. The definition of "state property" in section
26 2221 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The
27 Administrative Code of 1929, added June 22, 1999 (P.L.99,
28 No.15), is amended to read:

1 Section 2221. Definitions.--As used in this subarticle, the
2 following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to
3 them in this section:

4 * * *

5 "State property" shall mean property owned or leased by the
6 State government or an agency of the State government and
7 designated by the bureau as appropriate for participation in the
8 Business Enterprise Program. The term does not include property
9 which is owned or leased for:

10 (1) rest, recreation and safety rest areas on the national
11 system of interstate and defense highways;

12 (2) institutions of higher learning except as provided in
13 section 2239; [or]

14 (3) institutions of the Department of Corrections[.]; or

15 (4) State veterans' homes operated by the Department of
16 Military and Veterans Affairs.

18 Section 2. Section 2224(f) of the act, added June 22, 1999
19 (P.L.99, No.15), is amended to read:

20 Section 2224. Business Enterprises; Equipment; Leases;
21 Repayment.--* * *

22 (f) The department is authorized to receive and transmit to
23 the State Treasury for credit to the fund all money received by
24 the Commonwealth on account of contracts between the
25 Commonwealth, acting through the Department of General Services,
26 and vending machine owners, whereby the Commonwealth is to
27 receive a percentage of the profits from vending machines
28 operated in State buildings, except for those vending machines
29 in State veterans' homes and State buildings in which a
30 restaurant or cafeteria is operated by the Department of General

1 Services.

2 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
