## A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of December 14 through 20, 2015, as "Gospel 1 Music Week" in Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, Gospel music is a treasured art form unique to the 3 4 United States, which inspires and entertains across racial, ethnic, religious and geographic boundaries; and 5 6 WHEREAS, The origin of gospel music can be traced back to 7 African-American spirituals written by slaves to express their religious faith while in bondage; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Other unique American musical styles such as ragtime, jazz and blues would go on to shape this music into the 10 11 well-known form of gospel music celebrated today; and WHEREAS, Philadelphia served as a creative center of gospel 12 music and was home to musical talents such as Reverend Charles 13 14 Albert Tindley, the Clara Ward Singers and the Dixie Hummingbirds; and 15

WHEREAS, Since the 20th century, gospel music has inspired 3 some of America's greatest musical artists, including Sam Cooke, 4 Al Green, Elvis Presley, Marvin Gaye, Aretha Franklin, Whitney 5 Houston, Little Richard, Ray Charles, Buddy Holly, Alan Jackson, 6 7 Dolly Parton, Mariah Carey, Bob Dylan and Randy Travis; and 8 WHEREAS, Gospel music has grown beyond its roots to become a cornerstone of the American musical tradition, heavily 9 10 influencing the development of popular culture; and WHEREAS, Today, gospel music is celebrated by residents 11 12 throughout this Commonwealth and by multitudes of diverse music 13 lovers worldwide; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 14 15 week of December 14 through 20, 2015, as "Gospel Music Week" in
