## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 26, 1947 (P.L.318, No.140), entitled, as 1 amended, "An act relating to the practice of public 2 accounting; providing for the examination, education and 3 experience requirements for certification of certified public 4 accountants and for the licensing of certified public 5 accountants, public accountants and firms; requiring 6 continuing education and peer review; providing for the organization and ownership of firms and for the procedures 7 8 and grounds for discipline and reinstatement of licensees; 9 10 prescribing the powers and duties of the State Board of Accountancy and the Department of State; providing for 11 ownership of working papers and confidentiality; regulating 12 the professional responsibility of licensees; defining 13 unlawful acts and acts not unlawful; providing penalties; and 14 repealing existing laws, " establishing a continuing education 15 pilot program for certified public accountants assisting 16 volunteer firefighter organizations. 17

- 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 19 hereby enacts as follows:
- 20 Section 1. The act of May 26, 1947 (P.L.318, No.140), known
- as the CPA Law, reenacted and amended December 8, 1976 21
- (P.L.1280, No.286), is amended by adding a section to read: 22
- 23 Section 8.3. Continuing Education Pilot Program for
- Certified Public Accountants Assisting Volunteer Firefighter 24
- Organizations. -- (a) A continuing education pilot program for 25

- 1 certified public accountants assisting volunteer firefighter
- 2 organizations is established. The pilot program shall expire
- 3 after four years.
- 4 (b) The following shall apply to the pilot program:
- 5 (1) A certified public accountant may earn up to forty hours
- 6 of the continuing education requirement under section 8.2(b) of
- 7 this act.
- 8 (2) A certified public accountant may not be charged a
- 9 biennial renewal fee.
- 10 (3) Each hour earned may be used towards renewal of a
- 11 license and may not be used for reactivation of a license.
- 12 (4) A certified public accountant may only review the
- 13 financial statements and records of the volunteer firefighter
- 14 organization and may not perform auditing for the volunteer fire
- 15 organization.
- 16 (5) The pilot program shall be administered in accordance
- 17 with 49 Pa. Code § 11.71 (relating to responsibilities of CPE
- 18 program sponsor).
- 19 (6) Oversight of a certified public account shall be
- 20 conducted by a CPE program sponsor approved under 49 Pa. Code §
- 21 § 11.69a (relating to approval of CPE program sponsor).
- 22 (c) A certified public accountant must be a resident of this
- 23 Commonwealth in order to be eligible to participate in the pilot
- 24 program.
- 25 (d) A volunteer firefighter organization must be located in
- 26 this Commonwealth in order to be eligible to participate in the
- 27 pilot program.
- 28 (e) The following shall apply to liability:
- 29 (1) Each chief elected officer of a volunteer firefighter
- 30 organization, certified public accountant and CPE program

- 1 sponsor must sign a waiver of liability in order to participate
- 2 in the pilot program.
- 3 (2) A waiver under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall:
- 4 (i) Be considered as a contract among the signers.
- 5 (ii) Require\_that:
- 6 (A) The certified public accountant maintain confidentiality
- 7 concerning the volunteer firefighter organization, except for
- 8 illegal activities, and interact directly with the volunteer
- 9 firefighter organization's chief elected officer.
- 10 (B) The volunteer firefighter organization agree to give the
- 11 certified public accountant full access to the financial
- 12 statements and records of the volunteer firefighter organization
- 13 and the ability to report illegal activities the certified
- 14 public accountant finds without being subject to liability for
- 15 civil damages.
- 16 (C) The CPE program sponsor maintain confidentiality
- 17 concerning the volunteer firefighter organization and accept
- 18 responsibility for the certified public accountant's behavior
- 19 while interacting with the volunteer firefighter organization's
- 20 members and for the work the certified public accountant
- 21 performs.
- 22 (f) The following shall apply to procedure:
- 23 (1) A certified public accountant participating in the pilot
- 24 program:
- 25 (i) Shall be assigned by the CPE program sponsor to a
- 26 volunteer firefighter organization in the certified public
- 27 accountant's area. The certified public accountant must review
- 28 the financial statements or records of the volunteer firefighter
- 29 organization in a manner as provided under 49 Pa. Code § 11.68
- 30 (relating to documentation of CPE hours).

- 1 (ii) Must document and submit the certified public
- 2 accountant's hours to the CPE program sponsor after every
- 3 session with the volunteer firefighter organization.
- 4 (iii) Must, within seven days of the end of the second year
- 5 of the pilot program, submit a report to the certified public
- 6 accountant's CPE program sponsor consisting of each accounting
- 7 problem faced and each solution proposed to the volunteer
- 8 <u>firefighter\_organization</u>.
- 9 (2) A volunteer firefighter organization must submit to the
- 10 CPE program sponsor the volunteer firefighter organization's
- 11 name, address and telephone number in a letter indicating that
- 12 the volunteer firefighter organization is interested in
- 13 participating in the pilot program.
- 14 (3) A volunteer firefighter organization's chief elected
- 15 officer must submit to the CPE program sponsor an evaluation of
- 16 the certified public accountant's service. The CPE program
- 17 sponsor shall send a copy of the evaluation to the board for use
- 18 in the pilot program's overall evaluation.
- 19 (g) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 20 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 21 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 22 "Volunteer firefighter organization." A nonprofit chartered
- 23 corporation, association or organization located in this
- 24 Commonwealth which provides fire protection services and which
- 25 may offer other voluntary emergency services within this
- 26 Commonwealth. Voluntary emergency services provided by a
- 27 volunteer fire company may include voluntary ambulance and
- 28 <u>voluntary rescue services.</u>
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
