A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of February 21 through 27, 2016, as
- 2 "Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Awareness Week" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The word AED is an acronym used as an abbreviation
- 5 for the Automated External Defibrillator; and
- 6 WHEREAS, AEDs are portable medical devices that use
- 7 electrodes to automatically analyze and detect cardiac
- 8 arrhythmia of sudden cardiac arrest patients; and
- 9 WHEREAS, AEDs are able to produce a shock which stops the
- 10 heart and allows it to return to a normal rhythm, a process
- 11 called defibrillation; and
- 12 WHEREAS, AEDs are used in the event of a sudden cardiac
- 13 arrest, which is a condition in which the heart suddenly stops
- 14 pumping blood and quivers erratically; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Approximately 360,000 cases of sudden cardiac arrest
- 16 occur yearly, typically without any warning signs; and
- 17 WHEREAS, A person currently has about a 5% chance of
- 18 surviving an incident of cardiac arrest, which decreases 7% to

- 1 10% with every minute that passes after a person's heart stops
- 2 beating; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Optimal AED placement allows a person to grab the
- 4 AED and return to the victim within 90 seconds; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Given that a person's chances of surviving a sudden
- 6 cardiac arrest decrease so rapidly, it is important that AEDs
- 7 are readily available; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 9 week of February 21 through 27, 2016, as "Automated External
- 10 Defibrillator (AED) Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
