A RESOLUTION

Commemorating the 50th anniversary of the Tobyhanna Conservation 1 Association in Pennsylvania. 2 WHEREAS, On May 15, 1966, 12 Tobyhanna sportsmen founded an 3 organization dedicated to the preservation of hunting and 4 fishing in the spirit of true sportsmanship through example; and 5 WHEREAS, The members believed that nature's bounty in 6 providing man with fish and game is not inexhaustible, and that 7 man, through sincere efforts, may aid in the propagation of fish 8 and game species and the improvement of their environment; and 9 WHEREAS, The association's charter states: "Conservation, a 10 state of harmony between man and the land, and the proper 11 harvesting of fish and game so as to retain nature's delicate 12 balance, shall be the purpose of this organization"; and 13 WHEREAS, Over the years, the organization has managed 14 numerous projects and activities and has partnered with other 15 organizations with common interests to further advance the 16 17 conservation and sportsman's ethic; and

1 WHEREAS, The association constructed and maintains a 2 children's and handicapped persons fishing area on the Tobyhanna Creek on Main Street in Tobyhanna that provides easy access to 3 good fishing and is an asset to the community for all youngsters 4 5 and persons with disabilities to enjoy the great outdoors; and 6 WHEREAS, Through the organization's involvement with programs at Monroe County Conservation Camp for the past 25 years, they 7 have facilitated the construction by children of more than 500 8 bluebird boxes that are now scattered about the forests and 9 fields of Pennsylvania; and 10

11 WHEREAS, The association has participated in PennDOT's Adopt-12 A-Highway program for over 15 years, picking up trash on more 13 than seven miles of roadway several times a year in Coolbaugh 14 Township, Monroe County; and

15 WHEREAS, Members of the association participate in the annual 16 Tobyhanna Millpond #1 Ice Harvest, providing an appreciation of the importance of the historic natural ice industry; and 17 WHEREAS, Members of the association assist the Pennsylvania 18 19 Fish & Boat Commission with stocking trout in public streams 20 several times each year and maintain a section of the Tobyhanna Creek as a "delayed harvest fishing area" in cooperation with 21 the commission; and 22

23 WHEREAS, The association is affiliated with the Monroe County 24 Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs and the Pennsylvania Federation 25 of Sportsmen's Clubs to promote conservation at the regional and 26 State levels and to protect the future of Pennsylvania's great 27 outdoors; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Tobyhanna Conservation Association and proclaim its significance for the conservation of our precious
