- Recognizing the month of May 2016 as "Older Americans: Blaze a Trail Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives recognizes the energy,
- 4 aspirations and ongoing achievements of senior citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Senior citizens are the pillars upon which our
- 6 families have been built; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The increasing population of older adults in this
- 8 Commonwealth reflects a dramatic nationwide trend; and
- 9 WHEREAS, By 2050, the number of people reaching retirement
- 10 age will almost double; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Rural residents, on average, are older than urban
- 12 residents in this Commonwealth; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The number of senior citizens in rural Pennsylvania
- 14 is projected to increase 58% through 2030; and
- WHEREAS, May is traditionally recognized as "Older Americans
- 16 Month" in the United States; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Health and Human

- 1 Services Administration for Community Living has announced that
- 2 the theme of Older Americans Month 2016 is "Blaze a Trail"; and
- 3 WHEREAS, This year's theme raises awareness about important
- 4 issues facing older adults and highlights the ways older
- 5 Americans are advocating for themselves, their peers and their
- 6 communities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, This year marks the 51st anniversary of the Older
- 8 Americans Act, signed into law by President Lyndon Johnson in
- 9 1965; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Older Americans Act continues to provide a
- 11 nationwide aging services network and funding that helps older
- 12 adults live with dignity in the communities of their choice for
- 13 as long as possible; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Older adults are productive, active and influential
- 15 members of society, often having a positive impact on the lives
- 16 of others through the experiences and knowledge they share; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Systems and services in this Commonwealth must
- 18 adequately address the unique needs of current and future
- 19 generations of older Pennsylvanians to optimize health and
- 20 maintain independence; and
- 21 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth owes a great debt to older adults
- 22 who, united by historical experiences and strengthened by
- 23 diversity, interpret events through varied perspectives and
- 24 backgrounds to bring wisdom and insight into our communities;

- 26 WHEREAS, Older adults deserve recognition for the
- 27 contributions they have made and continue to make to the
- 28 culture, economy and character of the United States and this
- 29 Commonwealth; therefore be it
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor

- 1 Pennsylvania's senior citizens by recognizing the month of May
- 2 2016 as "Older Americans: Blaze a Trail Month" in Pennsylvania;

- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 5 residents of this Commonwealth to honor senior citizens and
- 6 persons who care for them during the month of May and throughout
- 7 the year and to assist in their journeys toward optimal health
