AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 4 and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 6 7 8 9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to elections," further providing for qualifications of electors 11 at primaries, for only enrolled electors to vote at primaries 12 or hold party offices, for candidates to be nominated and 13 party officers to be elected at primaries and for persons 14 entitled to vote and challenges. 15
