AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), 1 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the licensing of 2 eligible organizations to conduct games of chance, for the 3 licensing of persons to distribute games of chance, for the 4 registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for 5 suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; 6 requiring records; providing for local referendum by 7 electorate; and prescribing penalties," in preliminary 8 provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in games 9 of chance, providing for Texas Hold'em card tournaments. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 12 hereby enacts as follows:
- 13 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of December 19, 1988
- 14 (P.L.1262, No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of
- 15 Chance Act, is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 16 Section 103. Definitions.
- 17 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall,
- 18 except as provided under section 902, have the meanings given to
- 19 them in this section unless the context clearly indicates
- 20 otherwise:
- 21 * * *

- 1 "Texas Hold'em card tournament." A poker variant or
- 2 community card game where each player may use any combination of
- 3 five community cards and the player's own two hole cards to make
- 4 a poker hand. In tournament format, a player may bet up to the
- 5 amount of chips the player possesses.
- 6 * * *
- 7 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 <u>Section 301.2. Texas Hold'em card tournaments.</u>
- 9 (a) Conduct. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 10 act, Texas Hold'em card tournaments may be conducted by
- 11 volunteer fire companies to which a license has been issued
- 12 under this section up to four times per calendar year. All Texas
- 13 Hold'em card tournaments must be held on volunteer fire company
- 14 grounds. Revenue generated from Texas Hold'em card tournaments
- 15 shall be used for public interest purposes as permitted under
- 16 this chapter.
- 17 (b) Special license. -- A special license shall be required
- 18 for volunteer fire companies to conduct up to four Texas Hold'em
- 19 card tournaments per calendar year. A license fee of \$1,000
- 20 shall be charged to permit volunteer fire companies to conduct
- 21 up to four Texas Hold'em card tournaments per calendar year.
- 22 (c) Entry fee. -- A volunteer fire company may charge an entry
- 23 fee of no more than \$100 per person.
- 24 (d) Prizes. -- Notwithstanding section 302, volunteer fire
- 25 companies shall pay out prizes to no more than the top five
- 26 winning persons in a declining manner based on the player's
- 27 final placement in the Texas Hold'em card tournament. The prize
- 28 pool shall be based on entry fees collected.
- 29 (e) Costs and profits. -- A volunteer fire company may keep up
- 30 to 60% of the entry fees collected.

- 1 (f) Regulations. -- The department shall promulgate
- 2 regulations to impose standards and restrictions for the conduct
- 3 of Texas Hold'em card tournaments.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
