AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 12 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 18 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 commissions shall be determined," in Commonwealth budget 20 procedures, further providing for lapsing of funds. 21 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 22 23 hereby enacts as follows: Section 621(m) of the act of April 9, 1929 24 Section 1. (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, 25 amended November 26, 1997 (P.L.530, No.57), is amended to read: 26 27 Section 621. Lapsing of Funds. -- * * *

- 1 (m) The Secretary of the Budget shall have the power to
- 2 [waive] request a waiver for any of the provisions included in
- 3 section 621 upon written request of an agency justifying an
- 4 exception to these provisions [which is in the best interests of
- 5 the Commonwealth]. When the Secretary of the Budget decides to
- 6 approve an agency request for a waiver of these provisions, he
- 7 shall submit the agency request along with his own written
- 8 fiscal analysis and detailed justification for the waiver of
- 9 these provisions to the respective Chairmen of the Majority and
- 10 Minority Appropriations Committees in the House of
- 11 Representatives and the Senate [allowing a reasonable time] for
- 12 their review and [comment] approval by majority vote in both the
- 13 <u>Senate and House of Representatives</u>.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
