## A RESOLUTION

Designating October 10, 2016, as "Put the Brakes on Fatalities 1 Day" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, The number of highway deaths on Pennsylvania roads 4 totaled 1,200 in 2015, the second-lowest number since recordkeeping began in 1928; and 5 6 WHEREAS, There are many controllable causes of traffic 7 fatalities, including excessive speed, use of alcohol and drugs, inexperience and carelessness; and 8 9 WHEREAS, The National Society of Professional Engineers, the National Academy of Forensic Engineers, the Institute of 10 11 Transportation Engineers Expert Witness Council and a coalition 12 of government agencies have teamed up to focus national public awareness on October 10, 2016, on the cause of traffic 13 fatalities and the need to reduce the number of traffic 14 15 fatalities; and WHEREAS, On "Put the Brakes on Fatalities Day," all drivers 16
