## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 44 (Law and Justice) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in

firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for licenses and for licensing of dealers; and providing for

sheriffs and deputy sheriffs. 5

- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Sections 6109(h) and 6113(b) of Title 18 of the
- 9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 10 § 6109. Licenses.

- 12 (h) [Fee] Fees.--
- 13 [(1) In addition to fees described in paragraphs (2)(ii)
- and (3), the fee for a license to carry a firearm is \$19. 14
- 15 This includes all of the following:
- 16 A renewal notice processing fee of \$1.50.
- 17 (ii) An administrative fee of \$5 under section 14(2)
- 18 of the act of July 6, 1984 (P.L.614, No.127), known as
- 19 the Sheriff Fee Act.

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- 2 (3) An additional fee of \$1 shall be paid by the
  3 applicant for a license to carry a firearm and shall be
  4 remitted by the sheriff to the Firearms License Validation
  5 System Account, which is hereby established as a special
  6 restricted receipt account within the General Fund of the
- 7 State Treasury. The account shall be used for purposes under
- 8 subsection (1). Moneys credited to the account and any
- 9 investment income accrued are hereby appropriated on a
- 10 continuing basis to the Pennsylvania State Police.]
- 11 (4) No fee other than that provided by [this subsection or the Sheriff Fee Act] 44 Pa.C.S. § 7324 (relating to licenses) may be assessed by the sheriff for the performance

of any background check made pursuant to this act.

- 15 (5) The [fee is] <u>fees specified under 44 Pa.C.S. §</u>
  16 <u>7324(a)(1), (2) and (3) are payable to the sheriff to whom</u>
  17 the application is submitted and [is] <u>are payable at the time</u>
  18 of application for the license.

  (3), all other fees shall be refunded if the application is
  denied but shall not be refunded if a license is issued and
  subsequently revoked.

  25 carry a firearm for a fee in excess of the amounts fixed
  26 under [this subsection] 44 Pa.C.S. § 7324 commits a summary
  27 offense.

21	For the settlement or staying by the plaintiff of a writ
22	relating to property, execution not being concluded, the sheriff
23	shall receive the same fees for receiving, docketing and
24	returning, levying, advertising and performing other functions
25	enumerated in this subchapter, including commission as would be
26	chargeable if the sale had been made upon the writ, on the
27	amount paid to settle or stay the writ, whether the sum is paid
28	to the sheriff or to the plaintiff or a compromise is made
29	between plaintiff and defendant for the future payment to
30	satisfy the writ.

- 19 <u>supervision of the institutions</u>, or as the courts or boards may
- 20 approve, upon submitted bills to be paid by the county in
- 21 addition to compensation for services fixed by statute, by a

- 24 For attending court, when required to do so by law or by a
- 25 judge or district attorney, or bringing into or removing
- 26 prisoners for arraignment, trial or sentence or witnesses held
- 27 <u>in custody, an hourly rate equivalent to the prevailing wage</u>
- 28 scale of the performing sheriff's office shall be paid by the
- 29 county for each deputy or special deputy actually present.

1	(a) rees rol issuing and recording of a license, the
2	licensee shall pay, in addition to a fee payable to the county
3	or Commonwealth, the following fees:
4	(1) Issuing a license to sell firearms directly

11	(b) Additional fee An additional fee of \$3 shall be paid
12	by the applicant for a license to carry a firearm and shall be
13	remitted by the sheriff to the Firearms License Validation
14	System Account, which is established as a special restricted
15	receipt account within the General Fund. Money remitted to the
16	Firearms License Validation System Account and any investment
17	income accrued are appropriated on a continuing basis to the
18	Pennsylvania State Police.
19	§ 7325. Conservator of the peace.
20	(a) Sheriff For the services performed in the capacity as
21	a conservator of the peace or police officer in suppressing
22	riots, mobs or insurrections, and when discharging any duty
23	requiring the summoning of a posse, comitatus or special deputy
24	sheriffs, the sheriff shall receive per diem compensation at the
25	rate of \$50 in a county for eight hours' service, together with
26	the mileage and necessary expenses, including subsistence for
27	the sheriff and those employees supervised by the sheriff, all
28	to be paid by the county.
29	(b) Deputies For each special deputy appointed by the
30	sheriff in the case of an emergency, to assist in executing

- 1 civil or criminal process or court order or preserving the
- 2 peace, the sheriff shall receive from the county, for
- 3 compensation of the deputy, an hourly rate equal to the
- 4 prevailing wage scale of the sheriff's office, together with the
- 5 <u>expenses incurred for transportation and subsistence of the</u>
- 6 <u>deputy</u>.
- 7 <u>§ 7326.</u> Mileage.
- 8 For mileage in serving and executing writs, official notices,
- 9 rules, decrees, orders or processes, or copies thereof, or
- 10 performing the duties or services specified in this subchapter
- 11 or authorized by law, the sheriff shall receive and may tax as
- 12 official costs the mileage fee as established by section 1 of
- 13 the act of July 20, 1979 (P.L.156, No.51), referred to as the
- 14 <u>Uniform Mileage Fee Law, for each mile necessary to be traveled</u>
- 15 by the sheriff, deputies or employees. The mileage fee shall be
- 16 received on each separate writ, rule, order, decree, process or
- 17 <u>notice served or service performed. The sheriff shall not</u>
- 18 receive more than one mileage fee where the plaintiff and the
- 19 defendant and two or more contemporaneous writs are the same, or
- 20 when two or more persons or prisoners are being conducted at one
- 21 time to or from a place of detention or correction. The sheriff
- 22 <u>shall receive the mileage fee for transporting the prisoners and</u>
- 23 the deputies quarding them and meals and lodging during the
- 24 journey and the return of the deputies.
- 25 <u>§ 7327</u>. Appraisals.
- 26 For appraisal in a proceeding, the sheriff or an interested
- 27 party may petition the court having jurisdiction over the matter
- 28 for an order fixing the sum to be paid to the sheriff for
- 29 <u>services, for compensation of services of expert appraisers or</u>
- 30 for other property costs of making the appraisal, which sum

- 1 shall be a legal cost of proceedings. The court in its order
- 2 <u>shall determine who shall pay for the costs unless otherwise</u>
- 3 provided by law.
- 4 § 7328. Other matters.
- 5 For the executing of a matter directed to the sheriff or
- 6 required by law or rule of court, the performance of which is
- 7 <u>not mentioned in this subchapter, the sheriff shall receive the</u>
- 8 <u>same official fees, commissions and legal costs, including</u>
- 9 <u>mileage</u>, as for similar services specifically provided for by
- 10 <u>law.</u>
- 11 § 7329. Counties of the second class.
- 12 (a) Establishment and modification of fees. -- In counties of
- 13 the second class on or after the effective date of this section,
- 14 the sheriff may establish, increase, decrease, modify or
- 15 <u>eliminate fees and charges used exclusively to offset existing</u>
- 16 costs with the approval of the president judge of the court of
- 17 common pleas.
- 18 <u>(b) Additional fee for computerizing sheriff's office.--An</u>
- 19 additional fee of \$5 may be charged and collected by the sheriff
- 20 of a county of the second class for the initiation of any action
- 21 or legal proceeding. The additional fee shall be deposited into
- 22 <u>a special sheriff computer fund established in each county of</u>
- 23 the second class. Money in the special fund shall be used solely
- 24 for the purpose of computerizing the office of the sheriff.
- 25 § 7330. Costs to be additional.
- In addition to fees provided for in this subchapter, the
- 27 sheriff shall be paid costs, charges and expenses incident to
- 28 the performance of an act required by court, order, statute,
- 29 rule or regulation, including, but not limited to, printing
- 30 costs, publication costs, services of experts, watchmen, postage

- 1 and mileage, which shall be costs to be paid by the plaintiff,
- 2 <u>petitioner or person requiring them to be incurred.</u>
- 3 <u>§ 7331. Surcharge.</u>
- 4 There shall be assessed a surcharge on each fee collected by
- 5 the sheriff of every county upon acceptance for each service
- 6 required for any complaint, summons, writ or other legal paper
- 7 required to be served or posted by the sheriff of \$20, which
- 8 shall be collected by the sheriff of every county.
- 9 Section 3. Repeals are as follows:
- 10 (1) The General Assembly declares that the repeals under
- 11 paragraphs (2) and (3) are necessary to effectuate the
- 12 addition of 44 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 Subch. B.
- 13 (2) The act of July 6, 1984 (P.L.614, No.127), known as
- 14 the Sheriff Fee Act, is repealed.
- 15 (3) Section 8(b) of the act of February 9, 1984 (P.L.3,
- No.2), known as the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Education and
- 17 Training Act, is repealed.
- 18 Section 4. The addition of 44 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 Subch. B is a
- 19 continuation of the act of July 6, 1984 (P.L.614, No.127), known
- 20 as the Sheriff Fee Act. Except as otherwise provided in 44
- 21 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 Subch. B, all activities initiated under the
- 22 Sheriff Fee Act shall continue and remain in full force and
- 23 effect and may be completed under 44 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 Subch. B.
- 24 Orders, regulations, rules and decisions which were made under
- 25 the Sheriff Fee Act and which are in effect on the effective
- 26 date of 44 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 Subch. B shall remain in full force
- 27 and effect until revoked, vacated or modified under 44 Pa.C.S.
- 28 Ch. 73 Subch. B. Contracts, obligations and collective
- 29 bargaining agreements entered into under the Sheriff Fee Act
- 30 are not affected nor impaired by the repeal of the Sheriff Fee

- 1 Act.
- 2 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
