Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled, as reenacted and amended, "An act concerning townships of the 1 2 second class; and amending, revising, consolidating and 3 changing the law relating thereto, " in election of officers 4 5 and vacancies in office, further providing for vacancies in general. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 407 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, 10 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, is amended to 11 read: 12 Section 407. Vacancies in General. -- (a) If the electors of any township fail to choose a supervisor, tax collector or 13 14 auditor, or if any person elected to any office fails to serve 15 in the office, or if a vacancy occurs in the office by death, 16 resignation under subsection (b), removal from the township or 17 otherwise, the board of supervisors may appoint a successor who 18 is [an] a registered elector of the township and has resided in 19 that township continuously for at least one year prior to their

1 appointment .[, and, upon their failure to make the appointment within thirty days after the vacancy occurs, the vacancy shall 2 be filled within fifteen additional days by the vacancy board. 3 The vacancy board shall consist of the board of supervisors and 4 one elector of the township, who shall be appointed by the board 5 of supervisors at the board's first meeting each calendar year 6 or as soon after that as practical and who shall act as chairman 7 8 of the vacancy board. If the vacancy board fails to fill the 9 position within fifteen days, the chairman shall, or if there is 10 a vacancy in the chairmanship the remaining members of the vacancy board shall, petition the court of common pleas to fill 11 12 the vacancy. If two or more vacancies in the office of 13 supervisor occur on a three-member board or three or more 14 vacancies on a five-member board, the court of common pleas shall fill the vacancies upon presentation of petition signed by 15 not less than fifteen electors of the township. The successor so 16 appointed shall hold the office until the first Monday in 17 18 January after the first municipal election which occurs more 19 than sixty days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be elected for the unexpired term. } 20 21 (b) A resignation: 22 (1) Shall not create a vacancy until the date that the resignation is accepted by a majority vote of the board of 23 supervisors at a public meeting or the effective date of the 24 tendered resignation, whichever is later. The board of 25 supervisors must accept a tendered resignation no later than 26 forty-five days after the resignation has been tendered to the 27 board of supervisors, unless the resignation is withdrawn in 28 29 writing prior to acceptance.
